Godly leadership is a MUST! (take 2) – I Timothy 3:8-16

1. What is a deacon supposed to do again?

– Acts 6:1-7

Deacon = diakonos (*dee-ak'-on-os*)

an *attendant*, that is, (generally) a *waiter* (at table or in other menial duties);
(technically a *deacon* or *deaconess*): - deacon, minister, servant.

2. The qualifications to be a deacon

- I Timothy 3:8-13
- Well-respected
- Has integrity
- Not heavy drinkers
- Not dishonest with money
- Committed to Jesus
- Live with a clear conscience
- Must be respected
- Don't slander others
- Exercise self-control
- Very faithful
- Faithful to his wife
- Must manage his children & household well

3. Can a woman be a deacon?

- You have to listen to the message to get this answer! (hee, hee)

4. The truths of our faith

- I Timothy 3:14-16

- The church is not a business, it's a family.
- Our God lives!
- We CAN know the truth!
- God came in the flesh – His name is Jesus.
- He lived a sinless life.
- Even the angels testify to His resurrection.
- We need to preach Jesus to all the nations!
- Do you believe in Jesus?
- The glory that was His before coming to earth has been restored.
He is the King of Kings!
