Life = Worship – I Timothy 2:1-8

1. Prayer

“I urge you, first of all, to pray for all people. Ask God to help them; intercede on their behalf, and give thanks for them. Pray this way for kings and all who are in authority so that we can live peaceful and quiet lives marked by godliness and dignity.

This is good and pleases God our Savior, who wants everyone to be saved and to understand the truth.” ~ I Timothy 2:1-4 (NLT)

- Pray for all people. Don't be prejudiced in your prayers.
- Ask God to help people.
- Intervene for them through prayer.
- Give thanks for them.
- Pray for leaders and people in authority.
- This is beautiful to God. He is pleased when we pray in such a way.

2. Preach

“He gave His life to purchase freedom for everyone. This is the message God gave to the world at just the right time. And I have been chosen as a preacher and apostle to teach the Gentiles this message about faith and truth.

I'm not exaggerating – just telling the truth.” ~ I Timothy 2: 6-7 (NLT)

- Preachers must preach the truth.

To preach means ...

- (Strong's) G2784 - to *herald* (as a public *crier*), especially divine truth (the gospel): preach (-er), proclaim, publish
- (Strong's) G2097 - to *announce good news* (“evangelize”) especially the gospel
- (Strong's) G3056 - something *said* (including the *thought*); by implication a *topic* (subject of discourse), also *reasoning* (the mental faculty) or *motive*

3. Practice

“In every place of worship, I want men to pray with holy hands lifted up to God, free from anger and controversy.” ~ I Timothy 2:8 (NLT)

- Get 'em up!

– **An encouragement to fathers:** Pray with one hand on your child and one hand raised to Jesus. You want your kids to know that dad lifts holy hands in prayer.

Let's do this!
