Ministers in Skirts = 1 Timothy 2:9-15

1. Modesty

“And I want women to be modest in their appearance. They should wear decent and appropriate clothing and not draw attention to themselves by the way they fix their hair or by wearing gold or pearls or expensive clothes.”

~ I Timothy 2:9 (NLT)

Modest = having or showing a moderate or humble estimate of one’s merits, importance, etc.; free from vanity, egotism, boastfulness, or great pretensions. (Dictionary.com)

2. Full of good works

“For women who claim to be devoted to God should make themselves attractive by the good things they do.”~ I Timothy 2:10 (NLT)

It’s far better to be remembered for the good things you’ve done rather than what you look like.

3. “Women should learn” (this is HUGE!)

“Women should learn quietly and submissively.” ~ I Timothy 2:11 (NLT)

4. The issue of authority

“I do not let women teach men or have authority over them. Let them listen quietly. For God made Adam first and afterward he made Eve. And it was not Adam who was deceived by Satan. The woman was deceived, and sin was the result.” ~ I Timothy 2:12-14 (NLT)

God has designed the church to function a certain way. The question is, “Are we willing to submit to that design?”

5. Is a woman really saved by giving birth to a child?

“But women will be saved through childbearing, assuming they continue to live in faith, love, holiness, and modesty.” ~ I Timothy 2:15 (NLT)
