“Filled with awe” Habakkuk 3

1. Are you filled with awe?

“I have heard all about you, LORD.
I am filled with awe by your amazing works.
In this time of our deep need,
help us again as you did in years gone by.
And in your anger,
remember your mercy.” ~ Habakkuk 3:2

2. Habakkuk remembers how God has delivered His people in the past.

- Habakkuk 3:3-15
- God’s people have always been called to “remember.”

A few examples of God’s deliverance:

- God delivered the Israelites from bondage in Egypt.
- God defeated the heathen from before them in Canaan.
- God divided the Red Sea & Jordan because they stood in the way.
- God made water come out of a rock to give Israel drink.

- God made the sun & the moon stand still for Joshua.
- God keeps His promises and He is always faithful.

You need to take time and remember how God has delivered you and rescued you. The victories of the past give us confidence for the future.

3. Trembling and triumph

- The sight of our enemies and our many troubles can cause us to tremble. Even the judgments of God can be quite scary.
- Psalm 119:120
- Jesus will come in great glory.
- Jesus will come in great wrath.
- Jesus will bring salvation.

4. Habakkuk closes with a prayer of faith.

- Habakkuk repents of his fearful reaction to God’s judgment.
- Habakkuk confesses his faith in God and he knows that God keeps His promises, God is always faithful, and God will bring deliverance.

“yet I will rejoice in the LORD!
I will be joyful in the God of my salvation!
The Sovereign LORD is my strength!
He makes me as surefooted as a deer,
able to tread upon the heights.” ~ Habakkuk 3:18-19
